- Moving forward to establish position as a good long term decision for the university
- 2020 Strategic Plan talks about Diversity, Assurance document for re-accreditation Diversity plays an important part

- Hiring Process: Affirmative Action Plan Underutilization/Office of Institutional Equity are major players
