#### 4. Diversity Success Story

Carol Hicks: Revisiting an earlier story of a young woman who couldn't reenroll due to a debt issue; it is now resolved and she's enrolled for Fall.

Denise Rodriguez-Strawn: Recently accepted grad student who is both a person of color and a person with a disability. Student commented that applying to HSI's was challenging but that NMSU faculty and staff were warm and welcoming from her first interactions with us.

#### 5. Old Business

Denise Rodriguez-Strawn: Final call for information, programs, etc to include on the final report to President Floros regarding EID activities, which support staff, students and faculty

Update on VP of EID: Denise, Laura, Kimberly, Michael, Zooey, and Judith will meet with Pres. Floros on 4/21 for an update on the search. When these people met with President Floros on Feb. 19, he said he would have more information for us in two weeks, although we've had no update. Laura C. asked if there was any narrowing of the candidate field or plans for candidates to visit. Denise shared that field was narrowed to two people and there was a hope that candidates would visit. Laura C. asked if a summer start date was still the plan. Denise noted to ask President Floros about potential start dates at 4/21 meeting. Michael Ray shared that the search listing is still active on Isaacson Miller's website and on Google Jobs and that there is concern that perhaps additional candidates are being sought. Also, Michael shared that the search committee, DC, and Faculty Senate have heard nothing about the search thus far and it is another example of lack of transparency/communication. Laura C. mentioned in chat that the web page with the posting also lists that the search is "at an advanced stage; however, if you are interested in submitting materials, they will be reviewed until the search is formally closed..." Denise called for additional comments/questions from the Council to ask President Floros on 4/21. Laura C. suggested asking President Floros what the plan is if neither finalist accepts or remains available.
